



## Study Abroad Budget Worksheet

### Middlebury Schools in Italy

<b>Application fee</b>	You are responsible for paying application fees to your study abroad program.	
<b>Study Abroad Confirmation Fee</b>	Charged to Wheaton fee bill upon completion of confirmation paperwork.	\$500
<b>Tuition</b>	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	
<b>Accommodations</b>	Billed by and paid directly to your study abroad program.	
<b>Meals</b>	No meal plan is provided and you are not billed for any food expenses.	
<b>Flights</b>	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges. You will book your flight using STA Travel.	\$0
<b>Insurance</b>	You are required to either have Wheaton health insurance or you will be enrolled in and charged for CISI international insurance.	
<b>Academic field trips or excursions</b>	Some program excursions are included at no additional charge.	
<b>Airport Pick Up</b>	It is your responsibility to determine if your program offers airport transportation. You may be required to sign up for this service in advance.	
<b>On-site orientation</b>	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
<b>Visa fees</b>	Wheaton covers your visa application fees at no additional charge to you.	\$0
<b>Personal expenses</b>	Personal expenses may include: local transportation, books and supplies, passport fees, immunizations, personal travel, luggage fees, laundry expenses, student club fees, etc.	

An important step in planning your study abroad experience is considering the financial implications of your particular program. Federal, state, Wheaton need-based and merit scholarships will be applied to charges billed by Wheaton College. Students must consult with Student Financial Services for a comprehensive review of these fees.
