Application fee	You are responsible for paying application fees to your study abroad program.

Confirmation Fee	Charged to Wheaton fee bill upon completion of confirmation paperwork.	\$500
Tuition	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	
Program Deposit	Included in your tuition charges billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
Accommodations	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	
Meals	No meal plan is provided and you are not billed for any food expenses.	
Flights	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges. A group flight will be arranged by your study abroad program.	\$0
Insurance	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
Academic field trips	Some program excursions are included at no additional charge	
Airport Pick Up	It is your responsibility to determine if your program offers airport transportation. You may be required to sign up for this service in advance.	
On-site orientation	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
Transportation stipend	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, issued to you as a check for \$250	\$0
Visa fees	You are responsible for any fees associated with your study abroad visa application. Visa fees range from \$50-\$500, depending on country of citizenship and study abroad location.	
Personal expenses	Personal expenses may include: local transportation, books and supplies, passport fees, immunizations, personal travel, luggage fees, laundry expenses, optional program excursions, etc.	

An important step in planning your study abroad experience is considering the financial implications of your particular program. Federal, state, Wheaton need-based and merit scholarships will be applied to charges billed by Wheaton College.
