



## Study Abroad Budget Worksheet

### SIT Study Abroad IHP Programs

<b>Application fee</b>	You are responsible for paying application fees to your study abroad program.	
<b>Study Abroad Confirmation Fee</b>	Charged to Wheaton fee bill upon completion of confirmation paperwork.	\$500
<b>Tuition</b>	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	
<b>Accommodations</b>	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf.	
<b>Meals</b>	Billed by Wheaton, paid to program on your behalf, and all meals are provided.	
<b>Flights</b>	SIT will bill you directly for your flights. Wheaton will reimburse you \$1,250 for your flight expenses.	
<b>Insurance</b>	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
<b>Required Cell Phone</b>	You are responsible for this expense, as required by your study abroad program.	
<b>Academic field trips or excursions</b>	All program excursions are included at no additional charge	\$0
<b>Airport Pick Up</b>	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
<b>On-site orientation</b>	Included in your Wheaton tuition charges, paid to program on your behalf.	\$0
<b>Visa fees</b>	You are responsible for any fees associated with your study abroad visa application. Visa fees range from \$50-\$500, depending on country of citizenship and study abroad location.	
<b>Personal expenses</b>	Personal expenses may include: books and supplies, passport fees, immunizations, personal travel, luggage fees, laundry expenses, optional program excursions, etc.	

An important step in planning your study abroad experience is considering the financial implications of your particular program. Federal, state, Wheaton need-based and merit scholarships will be applied to charges billed by Wheaton College. Students must consult with Student Financial Services for a comprehensive review of these fees.
